

Ticket Sales Regulations For the AGRO SHOW 2026 Exhibition

§ 1

1. These Regulations set out the rules for the sale of tickets to the AGRO SHOW International Agricultural Exhibition, to be held from September 18 to 20, 2026, at the site of the former airfield in Bednary (Pobiedziska Municipality), hereinafter referred to as the "Exhibition."
2. The organizer of the Exhibition is the Polish Chamber of Commerce for Agricultural Machines and Equipment (Polska Izba Gospodarcza Maszyn i Urządzeń Rolniczych), located at ul. Poznańska 118, 87-100 Toruń; Tel.: (56) 651 47 40; e-mail: biuro@pigmiur.pl.

§ 2

1. Only individual tickets will be sold.
2. Tickets may be purchased:
 - 1) prior to the Exhibition via the Poznań International Fair (Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie Sp. z o.o.) sales system at <https://tobilet.pl/> under the "TARGI" tab,
 - 2) at the former Bednary airfield at designated sales points.

§ 3

The terms and conditions for purchasing tickets via the sales system of Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie Sp. z o.o. are set out in the Purchase Regulations for the ToBilet ticket distribution system, available on the ToBilet regulations page at [TOBILET.PL](https://tobilet.pl/).

§ 4

1. Subject to paragraph 2, ticket prices are as follows:
 - 1) for sales via the ToBilet sales system:
 - a. PLN 18 (reduced) for school-age youth and students up to 26 years of age,
 - b. PLN 18 (reduced) for seniors over 65 years of age,
 - c. PLN 23 (standard),
 - d. PLN 17 for persons with disabilities,
 - e. PLN 54 for the 2+1 package (2 adults + 1 child over 15 years of age / student up to 26 years of age),
 - f. PLN 69 for the 2+2 package (2 adults + 2 children over 15 years of age / students up to 26 years of age);
 - 2) for sales at the former airfield in Bednary:
 - a. PLN 20 (reduced) for school-age youth and students up to 26 years of age,
 - b. PLN 20 (reduced) for seniors over 65 years of age,
 - c. PLN 25 (standard),
 - d. PLN 19 for persons with disabilities.

2. Admission is free for persons up to 15 years of age.

§ 5

Tickets purchased at the former Bednary airfield are non-refundable.

§ 6

1. The ticket must be presented at the entrance to the exhibition so that its number can be scanned. Holders of reduced-rate tickets for school pupils and students must also present a valid

school or student ID, while seniors over the age of 65 are required to show an identity document. For tickets for persons with disabilities, a disability ID card must be presented.

2. This is a single-entry ticket; once the ticket number has been scanned, re-entry to the Exhibition using this ticket is not possible.

§ 7

Even if in possession of a valid ticket, the organizer may refuse entry to the Exhibition grounds particularly in the event of a violation of the Exhibition Regulations, the creation of a safety hazard, or visible intoxication from alcohol or other substances.

§ 8

Any complaints regarding tickets must be submitted to the Organizer no later than 7 days after the conclusion of the exhibition.

§ 9

In matters not covered by these Regulations, the Organizer makes the final decision.
